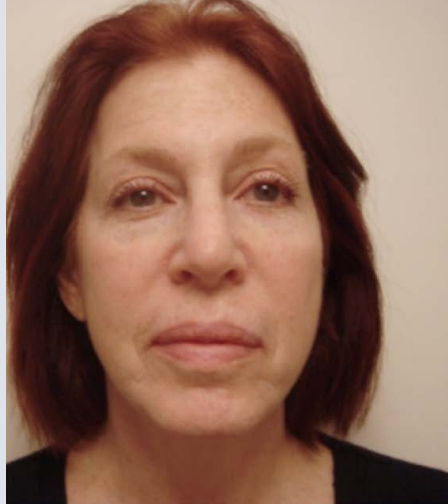

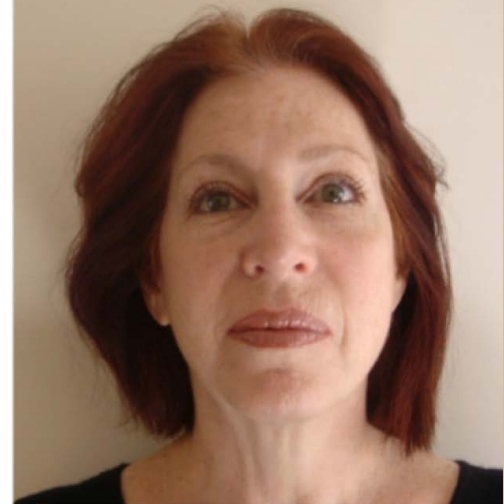

MEET YOUR FACE TEAM



Dr. Shellie Goldstein, DACM, AP, LAc, doctor of acupuncture and Chinese medicine and board-certified licensed acupuncturist, is the founder of the Academy of Advanced Cosmetic Acupuncture and Shellie Goldstein Acupuncture. She is the author of *Your Best Face Now: Look Younger in 20 Days With The Do-It-Yourself Acupressure Facelift* and the creator of *Touch + Glow: The Natural Facelift Kit*. Shellie is a recognized authority in the field of cosmetic facial acupuncture.



Dr. Yueying Li is a licensed acupuncturist with specialization in dermatology and over 36 years of experience teaching and practicing Chinese medicine. Dr. Li has been a professor at Yosan University of TCM in Los Angeles California since 1995 where she teaches both the master's and doctoral programs. Dr. Li established her private clinic practice in 1998 and continues her practice under the name of Art of Chinese Healing in West Los Angeles, where she sees her private patients and is training post-graduate Chinese medicine students to sharpen their clinical skills. FAQ

Would I be able to take certain classes without completing the entire program?

The FACE program is an eight-month, two-semester course. To receive the FACE certificate, you must complete the entire program.

Do I need to attend the live online classes or will they be recorded?

Although these classes will be recorded and available for review later, you must attend at least 75% of the live online classroom sessions to successfully pass the course. *Please note that if you are seeking continuing education credits for California, CA CEUs requires 100% attendance of all class dates within each course.*

Do I need to attend the clinical on-ground classes or will they be recorded?

These classes will not be recorded. In order to obtain a certificate of completion for the FACE program you must attend the clinical on-ground classes.

How long is the live-clinical training portion of the program?

The live-clinical training portion of the program is 8 consecutive days of intensive hands-on clinical mentorship with leaders in the field of acupuncture and facial aesthetics.

Where is the live-clinical training portion of the program located?

The live-clinical training portion of the program will be offered at the Pacific College of Health and Science campus in San Diego. In order to successfully complete the program, you will need to attend the live portion.

What options are available to finance my training?
